Over a glass of wine she proposed the prospect of me blending my own wine at Tulip Hill and recording a CD of music that would compliment it. Everyone loved the idea, and Aria was conceived. A natural pairing."

Q. Your favorite opera scene involving food or beverage:

A. "Food is definitely not as important as drinking in the opera world. From the toasts in 'Carmen' to welcome the Toreador, to the champagne toast by Prince Orlofsky in 'Die Fledermaus,' alcohol has been used as a social centering on stage. My favorite scene is the glorious music from 'Cavalleria Rusticana.' The town folk have just left the church after Easter Sunday services to celebrate a day of rest and leisure. They meet at the inn and raise their glasses in a robust, joyous toast to wine, life and love."

Q. Compare making Aria cuvee with making great music.

A. "Each requires attention to detail and feeling, and the resolution to trust

both. When blending my wine, I tried different combinations of varietals. Doing this took quite a bit of time as each blend was accompanied by deep conversation, discussing the emotions evoked by the wine, and of course fitting the blend to my palate. Ed West, the wine maker for Tulip Hill Winery, was extremely helpful.

"When choosing the music for Aria, I tried many songs. Not only did the songs need to touch my heart, but they needed to work in conjunction with each other. A song that sounds great by itself may not blend into the CD, much like a great cab grape might not be as good in a blended wine. After much savoring and singing from the soul, the music fell into place. A deep, rich experience on both levels of wine and music melded into Aria."

Q. What are your backstage treats?

A. "Backstage at The Met, there's a big table of different foods just outside of the dressing rooms. All performers enjoy the fare on the day of the performance. The foods vary with each production. By the end of the third act, the table is usually empty. My favorites are fresh fruits, finger sandwiches, apple strudel, pate and German chocolate cake."

Home remedies

Chicken soup can help relieve congestion by speeding up mucus movement through the nose, which limits the virus' contact with nasal linings.

What's more, you don't have to slave away over a hot stove to make homemade soup for your sick children. Researches believe that many canned soups also have these anti-inflammatory effects -- just be sure to avoid soups with high sodium content.

• Oatmeal can relieve dry, itchy or irritated skin. Using a food processor, grind the oatmeal into fine pieces. Then, sprinkle this oatmeal powder into warm bathwater for instant relief.

◆ Milk of magnesia can soothe the pain associated with canker sores; simply dab some of it on the sore three or four times a day to reduce the sting.

♦ Similarly, aloe can promote healing of mild to moderate burns.

PIPES: Stop freezeup

to prevent the cold line from freezing. Just wanted to let you know that the "hot water and-towels" method is nocost and really works.

—Blair W., White Plains, N.Y. Thanks for the story. Insulating pipes and monitoring the flow of water during cold spells are effective ways to prevent frozen and burst pipes. It's a good idea, when temperatures in your area drop well below normal, to let the taps drip steadily until the weather improves — water moving through the pipes will help prevent freezing as well.

This winter is already shaping up to be exceptionally cold and snowy in the East and Midwest. In addition to preventing pipe freezes, homeowners should make sure that heavy snow doesn't cause problems, either. High snowdrifts can cover vents you don't normally pay attention to, such as dryer and heating vents, potentially causing gases to back up into the house. Ice can form inside unshielded vent stacks, so that sewer gases don't vent properly. Clear snow and ice away from ventilation exit points as soon as a storm ends.

Choosing real or artificial turf

Q. Artificial turf has been popular on sports fields for decades for a variety of reasons, but is it also a good environmentally friendly option for residential lawns?

— Sharon Chinchilla, Ft. Lauderdale

A. The use of artificial turf for residential lawns is a growing trend across America, notably in regions where water supplies have a tough time keeping up with demand. Advocates of artificial turf point out, for example, that a whopping 56,000 gallons of water are applied each year to the average residential lawn.

Statistics also show that the mowing, watering and fertilizing of natural grass contribute as much as two percent to U.S. overall fossil fuel consumption. According to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, lawn care activities also account for about 10 percent of hazardous air pollution coast to coast. And studies on Long Island in New York state have shown that up to 60 percent of the synthetic nitrogen applied to lawns there ends up contaminating local ground water supplies. But given the choice between real or artificial turf, most environmental advocates still prefer real grass. Besides helping to create the oxygen we breathe through photosynthesis, plants (including grass) are an integral part of any living ecosystem. They filter water and sunlight down into the soil where worms, insects and moisture work in concert to hold the soil firm. And they prevent flooding while providing habitat and nourishment for birds, bees and other wildlife.

In contrast, synthetic turf is made of petroleum-derived plastic. In cases where fake turf is installed improperly, chemicals from the plastic can seep into the ground below and potentially contaminate groundwater. Some formulations of synthetic turf require infill such as silicon sand or granulated rubber, either of which may contain potentially toxic heavy metals that can leach into the water table below. The granules have also been known to produce a distinctly unpleasant odor at times. And consumers trying to reduce their carbon footprints should keep in mind that manufacturing and shipping artificial

turf, like any synthetic product, generates large amounts of greenhouse gas emissions.

Nonetheless, because of concerns about water usage, some municipalities are trying to encourage homeowners to switch to synthetic turf. Back in 2002, city managers in drought-ridden Las Vegas began offering homeowners rebates of \$1 per square foot to replace their thirsty natural grass lawns with synthetic turf. In July 2007, board members of southern California's Metropolitan Water District, which serves 18 million people across six counties, initiated a similar program to try to make a dent in outdoor water use in the region, 50 to 70 percent of which is devoted to the watering of residential lawns

Of course, installing artificial turf isn't the only way to minimize the environmental impact of one's yard. Converting grass lawns over to less resource intensive landscaping — known as "xeriscaping" — is also catching on. Drought-tolerant native shrubs, plants and ornamental grasses don't require large amounts of water, fertilizer or pesticides

to survive. Many groundcover plants naturally hold back weeds and contribute to the health of the soil. Rock gardens are attractive and essentially maintenance-free.

Given all the natural alternatives, homeowners need not convert their backyards over to fake turf.
